Bryan Park is located in the near northwest side of Richmond where I-64 West and I-95 North diverge. The main entrance to the park is located on Hermitage Rd. where it crosses I-95.

From the Fan:

Travel north on Boulevard (VA 161) across Broad Street and past The Diamond. At Westwood Ave. the Boulevard changes names to Hermitage Rd. Follow Hermitage Rd. north past Laburnum Ave. (A.P. Hill Statue) and the Scottish Rite Temple. As soon as you cross over I-95, the entrance is to your left.

From the West End:

Take I-64 E. Follow I-64 E to I-95 N to Washington. Take the first exit (½ mile, exit 80 - Hermitage Rd. / Lakeside Ave. / VA 161). Follow the signs to Hermitage Rd. Take a right and cross over I-95. As soon as you cross over I-95, the entrance is to your left.

From the Southside:

Take Powhite north across the James River to I-195 N. Take I-195 N to I-95 N toward Washington. Take exit 80 (Hermitage Rd. / Lakeside Ave. / VA 161). Follow the signs to Hermitage Rd. Take a right and cross over I-95. As soon as you cross over I-95, the entrance is to your left.

From the East:

Take I-64 W to where I-64 W and I-95N converge, and continue on I-64W/I-95N. As the roads diverge, take I-95 North toward Washington. Take the first exit (½ mile, exit 80 - Hermitage Rd. / Lakeside Ave. / VA 161). Follow the signs to Hermitage Rd. Take a right and cross over I-95. As soon as you cross over I-95, the entrance is to your left.

From the North:

Take I-95 S toward Richmond. Use exit 82 (Chamberlayne Ave. / US 301) and continue south on Chamberlayne Ave. Follow Chamberlayne across Azalea Ave. to the next light, Westbrook Ave. Take a right on Westbrook Ave. Follow Westbrook until it dead ends into Hermitage Rd. (VA 161) Take a right on Hermitage Rd. and cross over I-95. As soon as you cross over I-95, the entrance is to your left.

Carter Jones Park

2717 Bainbridge Street
Richmond, Virginia 23225
Field Dimensions: 58 yds. x 85 yds. (Summer '04)

The field is located Forest Hill area of south Richmond.

From Downtown, take the Robert E. Lee Bridge across the James River; it will turn into Cowardin Avenue (US 1 & 301). Cross Semmes Avenue (US 60) and take your fourth right, Bainbridge Street. Follow Bainbridge Street; the field is located on your right between W. 27th & W. 28th Street.

From Southside & Midlothian, take Forest Hill Avenue east. Take Forest Hill past the fork at Semmes Avenue. At W. 30th Street, Forest Hill Avenue curves left and changes names to Bainbridge Street; there is a fire station between W. 29th Street & W. 30th Street on the left. The field is located just past the fire station on the left hand side of the road.

Dorey Park

2999 Darbytown Road
Richmond, Virginia 23231
Field #7 Dimensions: 70 yds. x 110 yds. (Spring '04)

The field is located in Dorey Park in eastern Henrico County.

From north of the James River, take I-64 E, through downtown, to the Laburnum Ave. exit (exit 195). Head south on Laburnum, past the Nabisco plant to Darbytown Rd. Turn left, continuing on Darbytown past Strath Road; the park will be on your right.

From south of the James River, take Chippenham Parkway (VA 150) toward I-95. Upon crossing I-95, Chippenham will turn into VA 895 (it isn't officially I-895 yet, for all of you road geeks). You will then confront a \$1.50 toll. Soon after, take the first exit, Laburnum Avenue. Follow Laburnum Avenue through New Market Road (VA 5), and onto to the first major intersection, Darbytown Road. Turn right, continuing on Darbytown past Strath Road; the park will be on your right.

Fields #3, #4, #5 & #6: Once you enter the park, the fields will be on the right. They are numbered starting from the road. Field #1, closest to the main road, in known as "The Rugby Field". Field #2 is next, known as "the Flag Football Field". Fields #3, #4, #5 & #6 are the lit soccer fields that the CVSA will use. They are the last four toward the wooded area.

Field #7: The CVSA will continue to use the back field, known as Field #7, which is ½ mile from the entrance of the park on the left hand side, just past the equestrian area. For longtime CVSA players, this is the field that has been in use for the longest by the CVSA.

Elizabeth D. Redd Elementary School

5601 Jahnke Road
Richmond, Virginia 23225
Field Dimensions: 58 yds. x 85 yds. (Summer '04)

The field is located in the southside of the City of Richmond,

From the north, east, & west, take I-95 or I-64 to I-195. Follow I-195 to the Powhite Parkway (VA 76). Cross the James River and exit at Forest Hill Avenue (TOLL REQUIRED!). Take a left onto Forest Hill Avenue, heading east. Cross the railroad tracks and the next light will be Jahnke Road. Take a right on Jahnke, and follow it for about .75 miles and the entrance will be on your left.

From the south, take the Powhite Parkway (VA 76) to the Jahnke Road exit. Take a right on Jahnke, toward the city. Cross Chippenham, and continue on Jahnke past German School Road. Follow Jahnke about .75 miles past German School, and the school entrance will be on your right.

The field is behind the school.

Elkhardt Middle School

**6300 Hull Street Road
Richmond, Virginia 23225**
Field Dimensions: 75 yds. x 107 yds. (Spring '03)

The field is located on Hull Street Road (US 360), near the intersection with Chippenham Pky. (VA 150). Heading south on Chippenham, exit at Hull Street Road. Head east on Hull Street Road; take a left at the second light; the field is behind the brick school building.

Gillie's Creek

**901 Stony Run Drive
Richmond, Virginia 23231**
Field Dimensions: 58 yds. x 85 yds. (Summer '03)

The field is in Fulton Bottom in Gillie's Creek Nature Area.

From downtown, take Main Street east (VA 5), past Tobacco Row. Continue on Main; take your first left, Williamsburg Rd. After you pass the old Fulton Gas Works building, take the first left at Stony Run Drive. The frisbee disc golf course will be at the corner. Continue on Stony Run Drive, the field will be on your right.

John Marshall High School

**4225 Old Brook Road
Richmond, Virginia 23227**
Field Dimensions: 58 yds. x 85 yds. (Summer '04)

The field is located in the north side of the city of Richmond, near the Bryan Park Soccer Complex.

From the south, take I-95 north to exit 80 (Hermitage Rd. / Lakeside Ave. / VA 161). The exit will actually dump you onto Westbrook Ave. Veer left, and follow Westbrook Ave. past Westminster Canterbury. Continue on Westbrook through the traffic lights at Brook Road & Chamberlayne Avenue. Westbrook dead ends on block later at Old Brook Road. Take a right onto Old Brook Road; you will pass Henderson Middle School & John Marshall High School. Take the second left, Bellevue Ave., and follow it for about ¼ of a mile. The field will be on your left.

From the west, take I-64 east to I-95 north to exit 80 (Hermitage Rd. / Lakeside Ave. / VA 161). The exit will actually dump you onto Westbrook Ave. Veer left, and follow Westbrook Ave. past Westminster Canterbury. Continue on Westbrook through the traffic lights at Brook Road & Chamberlayne Avenue. Westbrook dead ends on block later at Old Brook Road. Take a right onto Old Brook Road; you will pass Henderson Middle School & John Marshall High School. Take the second left, Bellevue Ave., and follow it for about ¼ of a mile. Take a left off of Chamberlayne to Westbrook. Westbrook dead ends on block later at Old Brook Road. Take a right onto Old Brook Road; you will pass Henderson Middle School & John Marshall High School. Take the second left, Bellevue Ave., and follow it for about ¼ of a mile. The field will be on your left.

Montrose Heights

2022 Fenton Street

Richmond, Virginia 23231

Field Dimensions: 68 yds. x 102 yds. (Fall '04)

Field Dimensions: 58 yds. x 85 yds. (Summer '04)

The field is located in Richmond's Historic Fulton Hill District.

From I-64, take the Laburnum Ave. exit (exit 195). **Remember that this exit is east of Downtown; it is not the one off of I-64 at I-195!** Go south to Williamsburg Rd. (US 60). Take a right on Williamsburg Rd., heading back toward the city. Just after you cross the city limits take a right on Randall Ave. Follow Randall Ave. until it dead ends at the field. If you get to Government Rd. then you have gone too far on Williamsburg Rd.

From Richmond, take Main St. (VA 5) east through Shockoe Bottom. Take a left on Williamsburg Rd. and go through Fulton Hill past Government Rd. Take the third left which is Randall Ave and follow it to the field.

Shortcut to Onslow Minnis: take Fenton Street west, toward Government Road. Fenton will dead-end at Bunn Ave.; take a right. Follow Bunn, and Accomac St. merges from the right. Accomac will dead-end at Jennie Scher Rd.; take a left. Follow Jennie Scher to Government Road; take a right. Follow Government Road to Crestview Road which is the first right after the railroad tracks. Take a right on 38th Street, which will take you directly to the field.

Shortcut to Oakwood: take Fenton Street west, toward Government Road. Fenton will dead-end at Bunn Ave.; take a right. Follow Bunn, and Accomac St. merges from the right. Accomac will dead-end at Jennie Scher Rd.; take a right. Follow Jennie Scher through the housing project, past the Hebrew Cemetery on your right, across the railroad tracks, until it dead-ends at East Richmond Road; take a left. Follow East Richmond Road up the hill to the Oakwood Cemetery gates and turn left on Oakwood Ave. Take your first right, Canepa Street, and the field will be on your right.

Oakwood Cemetery

3400 Canepa Street
Richmond, Virginia 23223
Field Dimensions: 75 yds. x 112 yds. (Fall '04)

The field is located next to Oakwood Cemetery in Richmond's historic Church Hill.

From the south, north, or west, take your favorite interstate highway into downtown. Travel east on Broad Street into Church Hill. Take a left on Chimborazo Blvd., which is one block east of 33rd Street. Chimborazo will end at Oakwood Ave. Turn right onto Oakwood, heading for the cemetery gates. Take your fourth left (Canepa St.) and the field will be on your right.

From the east, take I-64 toward Richmond, exiting at Nine Mile Road (VA 33/Exit 193). Take Nine Mile Road west; after passing the front of the cemetery, the road forks; veer left onto 31st Street. Turn left at S Street (third left) until you get to Oakwood Ave. Turn left onto Oakwood, then take your next left on Canepa St. The field will be on your right.

Shortcut to Montrose: leaving the field, take a left onto Oakwood Ave. At the cemetery gates, the road turns right and is called East Richmond Road. Follow East Richmond Road down the hill. At the bottom of the hill, take a right at Jennie Scher Road. You will cross Gillie's Creek, and then the railroad tracks. Stay left, following Jennie Scher Road past the Hebrew Cemetery and through the housing project. Your first left will be Accomac Street. Follow Accomac Street to your third right, Luray Ave. Take a right on Luray, then a left on Fenton Street (your first left). The field will be on the left.

Shortcut to Onslow Minnis: leaving the field, take a right onto Oakwood Ave. Follow Oakwood to your first left, R Street. Take R Street to 38th Street, and take a right. 38th Street will take you directly to the field.

Onslow Minnis Middle School

701 N. 37th Street
Richmond, Virginia 23223
Field Dimensions: 68 yds. x 104 yds. (Fall '04)
Field Dimensions: 58 yds. x 85 yds. (Summer '02)

The field is located next to the Bill "Bojangles" Robinson playground in Richmond's historic Church Hill.

From the south, north, or west, take your favorite interstate highway into downtown. Travel east on Broad Street into Church Hill. Take a left on Chimborazo Blvd., which is one block east of 33rd Street. Go four blocks to M Street, and turn right. Go three blocks and the school will be on your left. The field is behind the school.

From the east, take I-64 toward Richmond, exiting at Nine Mile Road (VA 33/Exit 193). Take Nine Mile Road west; after passing the front of the cemetery, the road forks; veer left onto 31st Street. Turn left at M Street (ninth left); go six blocks to 37th Street and the school will be on your left. The field is behind the school.

Shortcut to Oakwood: From N Street, take 38th Street to R Street. Take a left on R Street and follow it to Oakwood Avenue. Take a right on Oakwood, then take your second left, Canepa Street. The field will be on your right.

Shortcut to Montrose: Take 39th Street south to Crestview Road. Turn left onto Crestview and go to Government Road. Turn left on Government Road, go over the railroad tracks, and take your second left at Jennie Scher Road. Follow Jennie Scher to the first right, Accomac Road. Take your third right at Luray Ave., then your first left at Fenton Street. The field will be on your left.

Richmond Sports Backers Stadium

100 Avenue of Champions

A. ARRIVING FROM I-95 HEADING SOUTH AND I-64 HEADING EAST

1. Take Exit #78
2. Make a right onto the Boulevard (VA 161)
3. The Sports Backers Stadium entrance is on the left (3001 North Boulevard) just after the stop light and the entrance to the Diamond. Sports Backers Stadium is 100 yards straight ahead.

B. ARRIVING FROM I-95 HEADING NORTH AND I-64 HEADING WEST

1. Take Exit #78 and make a left at the bottom of the exit ramp.
2. Take a right at the first traffic light onto Robin Hood Road.
3. Take a left at the next traffic light onto the Boulevard (VA 161).
4. The Sports Backers Stadium entrance is on the left (3001 North Boulevard) just after the stop light and the entrance to the Diamond. Sports Backers Stadium is 100 yards straight ahead.

Short Pump Middle School

4701 Pouncey Tract Road

Take I-64 W to the Short Pump exit. The exit will put you on Broad Street (US 250). Head west on Broad Street. Take a right on Pouncey Tract Rd (VA 271). Follow Pouncey Tract over the interstate; the field is in front of Short Pump Middle School on your right.

Thomas Jefferson High School

**4100 W. Grace Street
Richmond, Virginia 23230**

Field Dimensions: 58 yds. x 85 yds. (Summer '04)

The field is located in the near west end of the City of Richmond,

From the north & west, take I-95 or I-64 to I-195. Follow I-195 to the Broad Street / Hamilton Street exit. Follow Hamilton through the light at Broad Street. Take a right at the next light, Monument Ave. Take Monument to the next light, Malvern Avenue. The school will be on your left. The field is in the outfield of the baseball diamond.

From the south, take the Powhite Parkway to I-195. Take the Grove Ave. / Patterson Ave. exit. The exit will actually dump you onto Thompson Street - follow the signs to Patterson Ave. Take a left at Patterson Ave. Follow Patterson to the second light, Malvern Ave. Take a right on Malvern, follow through Monument Avenue. The school will be on your left. The field is in the outfield of the baseball diamond.

Thompson & Park

**620 N. Thompson Street
Richmond, Virginia 23221**

Field Dimensions: 58 yds. x 85 yds. (Summer '04)

The field is located between I-195 and Thompson Street, in the Upper Fan District of Richmond. The field is most easily accessible from Patterson Ave.

From the south, take the Powhite Pkwy. to I-195, exiting at the Patterson Ave./Grove Ave. exit. That exit will put you onto Thompson Street, which is one-way. Follow Thompson through the first traffic light (Patterson Ave.). The field will be on your left.

From the north, east, and west, take your local interstate highway (I-95S, I-64W, & I-64E, respectively) to I-195. Take the Broad Street/ Hamilton Street exit. Follow Hamilton Street and turn left at the third light, which is Patterson Ave. Take the next left (Thompson Street); the field is on the left.
